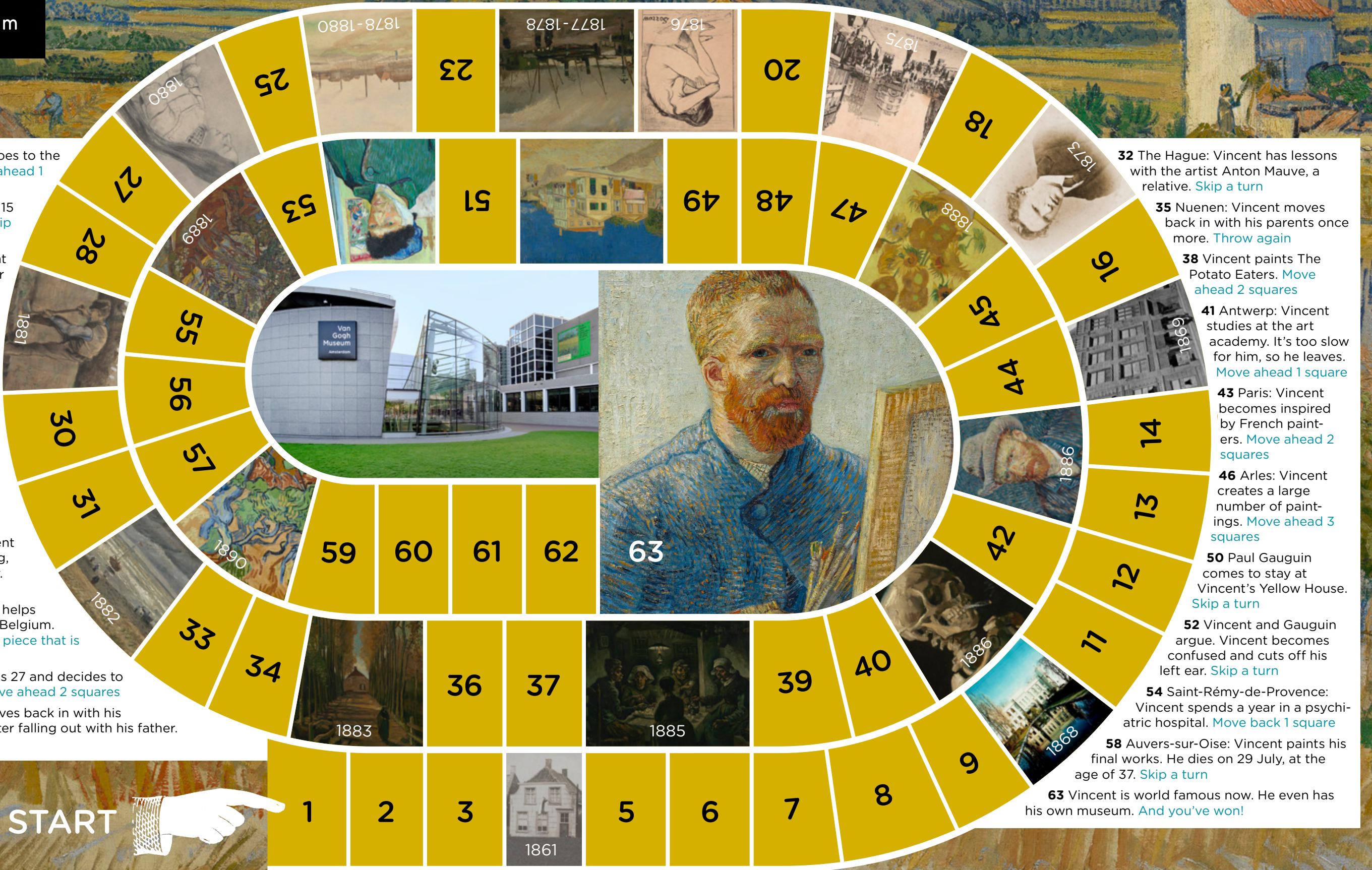

# Vincent van Gogh Board Game

- 4** Zundert: Vincent goes to the village school. [Move ahead 1 square](#)
- 10** Tilburg: Vincent is 15 and leaves school. [Skip a turn](#)
- 15** The Hague: Vincent gets a job working for an art dealer. [Throw again](#)
- 17** London: Vincent goes to work for the same art dealer, but now in England. [Move ahead 1 square](#)
- 19** Paris: Vincent goes to work for the same art dealer, but now in France. [Move ahead 1 square](#)
- 21** Vincent gets sacked. [Skip a turn](#)
- 22** Amsterdam: Vincent goes back to studying, but stops after a year. [Throw again](#)
- 24** Borinage: Vincent helps poor mineworkers in Belgium. [Swap places with the piece that is in last place](#)
- 26** Brussels: Vincent is 27 and decides to become an artist. [Move ahead 2 squares](#)
- 29** Etten: Vincent moves back in with his parents. He leaves after falling out with his father. [Move 1 square ahead](#)



- 32** The Hague: Vincent has lessons with the artist Anton Mauve, a relative. [Skip a turn](#)
- 35** Nuenen: Vincent moves back in with his parents once more. [Throw again](#)
- 38** Vincent paints The Potato Eaters. [Move ahead 2 squares](#)
- 41** Antwerp: Vincent studies at the art academy. It's too slow for him, so he leaves. [Move ahead 1 square](#)
- 43** Paris: Vincent becomes inspired by French painters. [Move ahead 2 squares](#)
- 46** Arles: Vincent creates a large number of paintings. [Move ahead 3 squares](#)
- 50** Paul Gauguin comes to stay at Vincent's Yellow House. [Skip a turn](#)
- 52** Vincent and Gauguin argue. Vincent becomes confused and cuts off his left ear. [Skip a turn](#)
- 54** Saint-Rémy-de-Provence: Vincent spends a year in a psychiatric hospital. [Move back 1 square](#)
- 58** Auvers-sur-Oise: Vincent paints his final works. He dies on 29 July, at the age of 37. [Skip a turn](#)
